

**AR Electronique
Conflict Minerals/Metals Statement**

In response to customer inquiries regarding compliance with Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Act, relating to conflict minerals (also referred to in the marketplace as “conflict metals”) originating from the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) and neighboring countries, Advanced Interconnections Corp. has prepared this statement. The scope of this statement is limited to the Conflict minerals currently defined as Tin, Tantalum, Tungsten, and Gold; also referred to as “3TG minerals.” Of these minerals, only Gold and Tin are present in the materials used in the manufacture of our products.

AR ELECTRONIQUE does not procure 3TG minerals directly from mines or smelters. Furthermore there are multiple supply chain layers that separate us from smelters and mines from which these minerals are sourced. Consequently, we require our suppliers to determine the sources from which these minerals are sourced. Based upon information provided by our suppliers, AR ELECTRONIQUE's products do not knowingly contain metals derived from the DRC conflict region.
